

## W Business District Dialogue February Edition



The Factory - Construction continues indoors. The primary focus has been getting plumbing and electricity throughout the building and installing lower level floors. Anticipated opening is in Spring.

Town Square - Bids have been received, and we anticipate awarding the construction project soon. We expect work to begin in Spring.

Preservation Park - At this time, the dumpster enclosure and small shed are mostly complete. Final painting and attachments will take place once the weather warms up. The pavilion will be built in late winter/early spring. Final landscaping is anticipated in April/May.

Parking Lot at 50527 Cherry Hill - Construction for the 50527 Cherry Hill Parking Lot, weather pending, will begin in March and should run to mid-May. Anglin Construction will be expanding the existing public lot off Independence St. and incorporating sidewalks to connect to the adjacent pathways.
