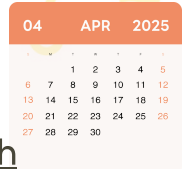

Development Updates

The construction for 50527 Cherry Hill Parking Lot, is slated to begin within the next two weeks and should run through the end of May. Anglin Construction will be expanding the existing public lot off Independence St. and incorporating sidewalks to connect to the adjacent pathways. The Cherry Hill frontage will remain open for future development. Per Canton Township Ordinance, construction is allowed daily Monday-Saturday 7 am-7 pm. At this time, residents and business personnel who use the current parking lot will need to relocate vehicles to another public lot; the closest is around Cherry Hill School.
